MY CHILD HAS DIFFICULTY WITH:

Speaking clearly: I understand, but others do not.

Hearing: Does not respond to her/his name, or when others speak to her/

different way than other children, does not play with other children.

In addition to the other list,

Does not follow parents/adults instructions or classroom agreements (social skills)

Does not dress self, or use toilet (self-help skills)

Difficult to calm down when upset or agitated (self-regulation)

Does not scribble/draw, does not play with small blocks or small toys (fine motor)

Does not jump, climb on playground equipment (gross motor)
